


# Bulletin 1

Three years ago, two high school students on NAG drew an indoor map of their school. First, the map was used for a training with two local clubs. The next year we had a bit of an upgrade and it was used for a competition the day after the Danish Night Champs. Now it is time for the culmination. The day before World Master Orienteering Championships in Copenhagen, we invite everyone to get this spectacular indoor orienteering experience.



The event is being held on the 6th July, at Nærum Gymnasium: Nærum Hovedgade 30  
You can start from 10:00 to 15:00. The Event Centre will be open from 9:30. The opening ceremony for WMOC is at 16:00 and is only 20 minutes away by car.

The map was first drawn in 2016 and it has been updated for this event. This year we have added a whole new building to the map and of course, moved some tables and closed some doors, so even if you have run at NAG before, it will be a totally new experience.  
The scale is approx 1:200 and the map will be printed on A3.





The event will be at Nærum Gymnasium (Gymnasium is High School in Danish). The high school was built in 2003. The running surface is tiles and linoleum. We recommend clean running shoes. It is not permitted to run in shoes with spikes. In the running area there is a mixture of classrooms and open working spaces. The main building has five floors. In the centre of the building is a library.

Be prepared for some intense (map) reading. The second building - called the ellipse - has three floors. There are some trees and bushes to be found in the area. The visibility is generally good. From the finish area spectators can watch the runners on the different floors.



### Classes and courses

Course 1 - The hardcore for men	Very Hard	Long
Course 2 - The hardcore for Women	Very Hard	Long
Course 3 - The tough	Hard	Long
Course 4 - The semi tough	Hard	Medium long
Course 5 - The oldies	Blue	Short
Course 6 - For beginners	Easy	Short

### Controlsystem

There is SportIdent timing. You will have to enter your SI number when you enter. You can hire an SI card for 15 kr. If you lose it, there will be a 400 kr fine.

### Start

The start is Put and Run. You can start from 10:30 to 15:00.

### Arena Facilities

There will be toilets and showers close to the arena.

It will not be possible to buy food at the arena, but there is a supermarket 50 metres from the arena.

### Prices and how to enter

There is entry on the day. Make sure to go to the information when you arrive to sign up.

The price is 50 danish kroner or 7 Euro (for participation and map). It is only possible to pay in cash in DKK or Euro.
